Wilkes-Barre, PA Eager to Implement the Total Enforcement Records Management System for Its Police Department

MELVILLE, NY, May 16, 2011: Wilkes-Barre Mayor Tom Leighton announced, on Tuesday May 10, 2011, the addition of a new electronic Records Management System (RMS) to be implemented in the upcoming months for the city's police department. The Wilkes-Barre Police Department selected Total Enforcement (TE) for its RMS.

The mayor referred to the changes in the city police department as "the start of a new chapter" and informed residents that the new system will allow officers to write and access reports and search city databases of problem properties right from their patrol cars.

"Whether it's purchasing new handguns, Tasers, bulletproof vests, or new police vehicles, we have consistently made sure our officers are supplied with the newest technology, training and equipment to patrol our streets and keep our residents safe," Leighton said. "Our officers do a dangerous job every day. They should be supported not just with our praise but with the tools they need to get the job done and make sure they come home safe."

In addition to being able to write and access reports from their vehicles on computers, officers will be able to check the status of ongoing cases and query certain addresses, using an electronic database. The system will help police share information with code enforcement and the community action team on nuisance properties, Leighton and Dessoie said.

Training on the new records management system begins on May 16 and will be complete within two months, the mayor said.
